# The key thing you need to know

The Gas Qualifications has sent multiple 5MM Communications out to all PG&E Approved 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Party OQ Evaluators that administer PG&E OQ testing to complete their OQ Evaluator re-assessments and make a choice by **August 31<sup>st</sup>**, **2020** on whether they want to hold OQ's to perform covered task work or administer PG&E OQ exams, they will not be approved for both.

# Why it matters to you

Effective close of business **September 21**<sup>st</sup>, **2020** PG&E approved 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> party OQ Evaluators who are performing covered task work will have their OQ's removed from ITS. Again, to be perfectly clear, after Monday **September 21**<sup>st</sup>, **2020** these Evaluators will no longer be qualified to perform covered task work.

## **Key discussion points**

- The Gas Qualifications Team has agreed that 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> party OQ Evaluators who only hold PE Pipe Fusion / Connection or Welding OQ's can still maintain their Evaluator Status
- The PE Pipe Fusion / Connection and Welding OQ exams are only delivered by PG&E OQ Evaluators so there is no conflict of interest for 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> party OQ Evaluators holding "ONLY" those OQ's
