The PG&E Competency Assessment Program has created a series of online onboardings for all relevant Vegetation Management field tree work employees to reinforce specific topics, helping you prepare to work at PG&E.

Key Discussion Points

Required Online Onboardings for Vegetation Management

All tree crew workers are required to complete assigned onboardings through the ITS platform.

- Starting **January 1, 2025**, all onboardings must be completed **prior** to coming to the Competency Assessment Yard
- Workers already assessed must complete all onboardings by March 1, 2025.

Actions Required:

Assigning the Onboardings

Vendors must register all workers for the Onboardings through ITS. To do so, vendors need to add their workers to the "Tree Crew Onboarding" role in ITS. This will automatically assign all Onboardings to the tree crew workers.

Note: Whenever creating a new profile for a tree crew worker, vendors must add this role to the worker to assign the onboardings.

Accessing the Onboardings

The onboarding items must be accessed through ITS. All tree crew workers have a profile and login. They will need access to login into their own account to take the onboarding items—including their unique email and password.
