Electric Charges

Starting in March 2026, this charge will be replaced with Base Services Charge. All PG&E customers pay the Minimum Delivery Charges monthly to stay connected to the grid. The Energy Charge is used to pay for the generation of electricity that PG&E provides, and will not affect your monthly bill but may increase the amount owed at True-Up.

Explanation of Calculations

Your YTD Estimated NEM Charges represents the total charges for energy used, net of any credits for energy exported to the grid.

NEM Charges are calculated each month but are not billed until the end of the True-Up period. This True-Up process allows you to use credits generated in a given month to offset charges across other months within the True-Up period, which is typically 12 billing cycles. Your Summary of NEM Charges will be reset to zero at True-Up.

The Minimum Delivery Charge is billed monthly and credited at True-Up if the total NEM Charges Before Taxes are greater than your cumulative Minimum Delivery Charges.

Energy Charges are basic commodity costs related to energy usage. These charges will only be billed at True-Up if they are a positive amount and when the total NEM Charges Before Taxes are less than the sum of your total Minimum Delivery Charges and Energy Charges.

You may be eligible for Net Surplus Compensation (NSC) at True-Up if your Net Usage (kWh) is negative. Your NSC is calculated at True-Up based on that month's market prices. If this were your True-Up statement, your estimated NSC would be -\$0.37 (-12 kWh @ \$0.030940/kWh).

This is your YTD balance. Your total NEM Charges will be reconciled on your True-Up statement (01/2027).




NEM Charges Before Taxes

It covers the infrastructure and maintenance costs for connecting to the grid, energy programs, call center services, and billing. This charge can not be offset by generation credits at True-Up.
