Details of Solar Billing Plan Charges

Energy Export Credit Bank

HOW ENERGY EXPORT CREDITS WORK

You may be eligible for up to two types of credits: 1. Energy Produced credits can only offset Energy Produced charges 2. Energy Delivered credits can only offset Energy Delivered charges. Any credits unable to offset your monthly charges will be saved to help offset future bill charges. You can use your Energy Export Credit Bank below to track your monthly credits.

Energy Export Credits are only available for solar energy exported to the grid as required by state law.

¹ Customers with storage less than or equal to 10 kW in size are not required to meter their associated solar system.

² Energy Export Credits for Energy Produced are capped after calculating the solar energy your system produced (using estimated or metered data) and sent to the grid.

KEY TERMS

- Energy Produced:** This section of the bill shows charges for energy produced by PG&E, and credits for your extra solar energy produced. If you are a customer of a Community Choice Aggregator (CCA), these charges and credits will be determined by your CCA, not PG&E.
- Energy Delivered:** This section of the bill shows charges for PG&E energy delivered to your business, and credits for your extra solar energy delivered to PG&E.
- Energy Export Credits:** Credits for excess energy your solar system produces and sends to the grid. Value of credits will vary by hour, month, and weekday/weekend to reflect the value the power provided at a given time.
- Non-Bypassable Charges:** Charges all PG&E customers pay to help fund energy efficiency programs available to all customers as well as energy assistance programs for lower income households.
