

We are enhancing our network of advanced weather stations across our service area. These stations are monitoring for severe weather year-round, helping prevent potential wildfires.

## What is a weather station?

Weather stations measure changing weather conditions. This helps us decide if shutting off the power is necessary for public safety.

## Where are weather stations located?

- Primarily in high fire-threat areas across our service area
- On exposed mountains and hilltops to track offshore wind events
- On existing assets and non-intrusive, 20foot standalone poles
