

## **Community Wildfire Safety Program PG&E Wildfire Safety Webinar – Tehama, Glenn and Colusa Counties – Post-Event Report**

On May 28, PG&E held a Wildfire Safety Webinar for customers in Tehama, Glenn and Colusa counties, in accordance with the Settlement Agreement approved by the May 7, 2020, California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) Decision (D.) 20-05-019 Order Instituting Investigation (OII) regarding the 2017 and 2018 wildfires.

PG&E is listening to customer feedback to help understand how we can continue to improve wildfire prevention efforts, including situational awareness and the Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) Program. The purpose of the event was to share safety and prevention activities, utility service-related information and customer resources, gather input and respond to questions.

The event featured a 60-minute presentation on the implementation of PG&E's Community Wildfire Safety Program in Tehama, Glenn and Colusa counties with multiple Q&A sessions. The presentation focused on PG&E's layers of protection, wildfire risk, situational awareness, Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS), safety tips and customer resources. Participants could either join via the virtual conference platform or by calling into a toll-free number. Closed captioning was available in English, Spanish and Chinese.

### Event Outreach

PG&E conducted outreach through a variety of channels to drive attendance to the event. Outreach included:

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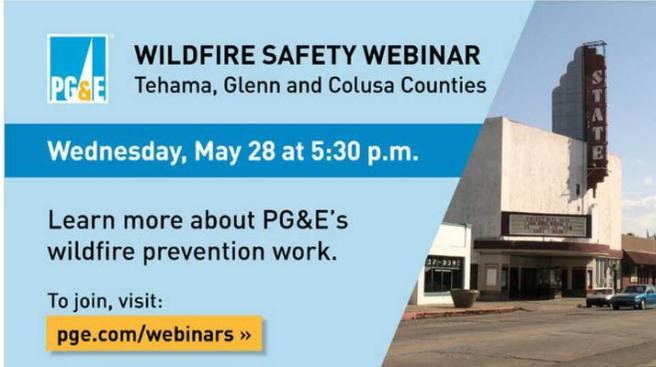

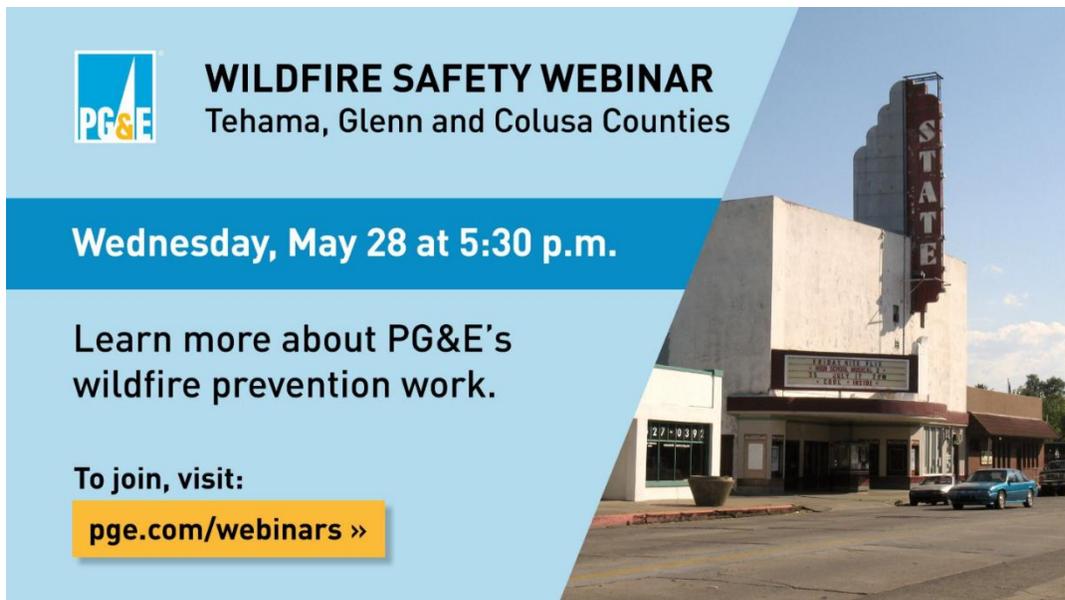
