



Wildfire Safety Progress Map

Undergrounding and System Upgrades Layers

Every day, we are using multiple layers of wildfire safety protection to ensure we are providing safe and reliable electricity to our customers. This can include moving some powerlines underground and installing strengthened poles and covered powerlines above ground in high wildfire-risk areas.

To help customers and communities view where this important safety work has been completed or is forecast, PG&E has developed an interactive mapping tool available in mobile or desktop web browsers. This map shows project routes, potential traffic control measures up to two weeks ahead of work and road restoration details.

Using the progress map




1 Use the search bar to type in your address, city, county or tribe. Begin exploring the map by zooming in or out of a particular area of interest.

2 Click on the icons or project routes to learn more about undergrounding and system upgrades work. Each type of improvement is represented by a color/icon defined in the legend in the bottom left-hand corner.


3 Navigate to explore information about other layers of wildfire safety protection using the drop down menu on the left-hand side of the page.

4 Additional traffic control and road restoration layers are also available (more information on reverse).




Traffic Alerts and Controls

Click on **Traffic Alerts** under the **Undergrounding and System Upgrades (Hardening)** tab. This view has updated information, up to two weeks ahead of work, on traffic control efforts related to our undergrounding and system upgrade work. Click on the colored project areas to view additional information.



Road Restoration and Cleanup Status

Click on **Road Restoration Status** under the **Undergrounding and System Upgrades (Hardening)** tab. This shows information, updated nightly, on temporary and final road restoration work. Click on the colored project areas to view additional information.
