PG&E is exploring upgrades to the electric system in your area to reduce the risk of wildfires. This may include moving some powerlines underground, installing strengthened poles and covered powerlines or other safety improvements.

While preparing for and performing wildfire safety work, we conduct a variety of assessments and surveys in and around project areas. You may see PG&E crews or contractors on or near your property and in your community. All PG&E crews and contractors carry photo ID and are happy to provide it upon request.

What is PG&E assessing or surveying?

Survey and Assessment Information	
Who	PG&E or Contractor Environmental Experts
What	Surveying and assessing proposed project areas.
When	Up to a year before any potential construction through project completion.
How	<p>The environmental assessment team will observe the project area by car or on foot. The team may also use:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Binoculars or spotting scopes. • Flags to mark boundaries or sensitive areas. • Hand tools. • Excavators at specific points in the project area (PG&E will coordinate with customers prior to use on properties). <p>Once completed, the area will be restored.</p>
