



Would a power outage impact your health, safety or independence?

Let PG&E know.

Enroll in one of PG&E's support programs to receive more assistance.

You may be eligible for the Medical Baseline Program if you use a qualifying medical device or have an ongoing medical condition with certain heating or cooling needs.

You could receive:

- More alerts and support before and during a Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) and other emergencies.
- More energy at your current rate or receive a discount on your current bill.

Some qualifying devices include:

- Motorized wheelchairs
- CPAP machines
- Respirators
- Dialysis machines

If you don't qualify for Medical Baseline but need more support, sign up for the Self-Identified Vulnerable Program.

You could receive:

- More alerts and support before and during a PSPS and other emergencies.
- Extra notice before power is shut off due to nonpayment.
- Access to resources like backup power options if you live in a high fire-risk area.
