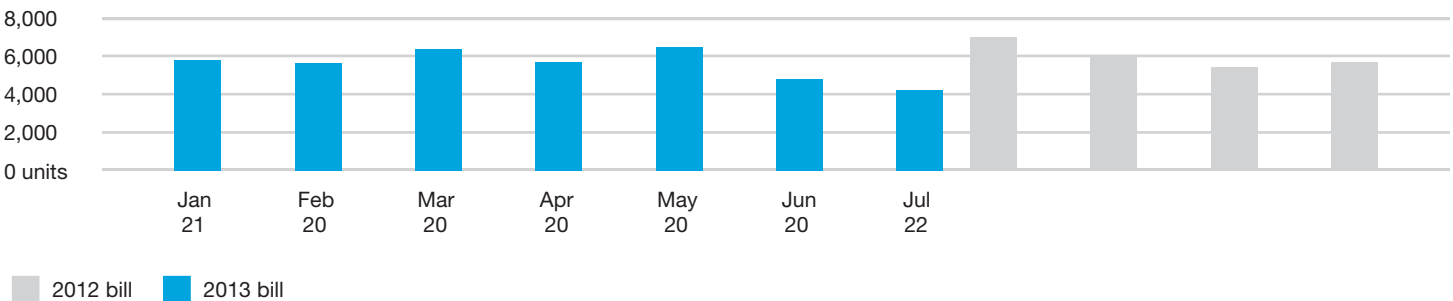

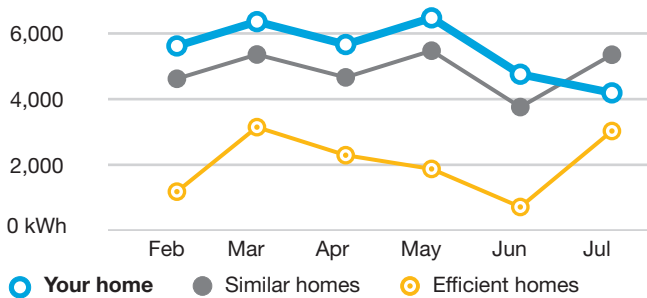
Upgrade to an efficient washing machine

Clothes washers can use a significant amount of water and energy, especially if you use warm or hot water.

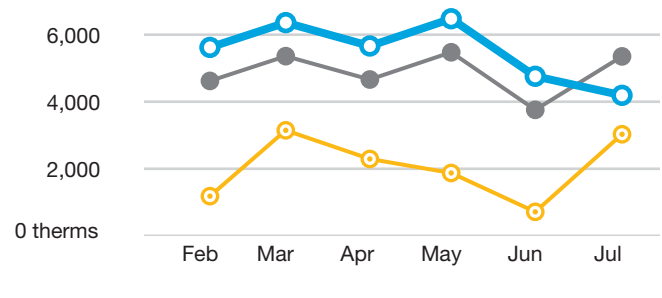

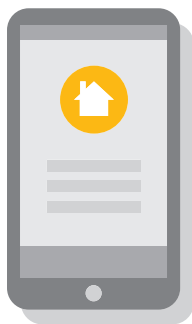
