Keeping you safe with layers of wildfire protection



These safety efforts help prevent wildfires and make our system more reliable.

-  **Advanced Monitoring** Using weather stations and cameras to gather real-time data
-  **Safety and Infrastructure Protection** Deploying experts to protect your hometown and our equipment
-  **System Upgrades** Installing strengthened poles and lines to improve wildfire safety
-  **Vegetation Management** Trimming or removing trees to keep them away from powerlines
-  **Undergrounding** Undergrounding powerlines in the highest wildfire-risk areas
-  **Enhanced Safety Settings** Using safety settings that shut off power quickly if a hazard is detected
-  **Public Safety Power Shutoffs** Turning off power for safety as a last resort when risk is highest

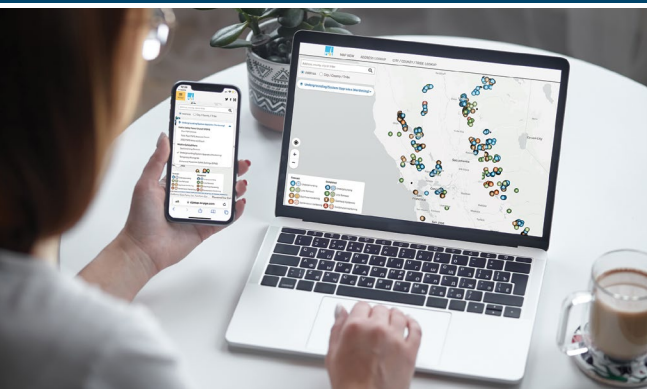
Emergency planning support through 211
