Opportunity Description:

Background:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (www.pge.com), a subsidiary of PG&E Corporation, is one of the largest combined natural gas and electric energy companies in the United States. Based in Oakland with more than 23,000 employees, the company is the primary natural gas and electric service provider for Northern and Central California. The company's 70,000-square-mile service area stretches from Eureka to the north to Bakersfield in the south and from the Pacific Ocean in the west to the Sierra Nevada in the east. PG&E delivers some of the nation's cleanest energy to 16 million people.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) was incorporated in California in 1905. Our customers include over 20,000 schools, 3,000 hospitals, 20,000 high-tech companies, and 700 military facilities. PG&E provides electricity to over 4.9 million customers and natural gas to over 3.9 million customers.

The RFP evaluation process is intended to provide opportunities for successful firms to expand their business with PG&E, new firms to establish business with PG&E, and for PG&E to realize reductions in costs, both internal and external, while experiencing enhanced commitment to corporate values. This will be an exciting opportunity for PG&E and its suppliers – both current and new – to reshape the way we work together and to improve PG&E's operations.

Contract Opportunity Description:

PG&E will be conducting an RFP for Marine Construction Services for Power Generation (Hydro) and Gas Transmission and Transmission work in the Bay Delta Area.

Scope of Work: Contractor agrees to furnish labor, materials, tools, equipment and supervision necessary to perform diving services. Types of underwater work to be performed include, but is not limited to, Inspection, Repair, General Maintenance / Cleaning and Construction Work. Common Inspection tasks include, but are not limited to performing, underwater inspections and documenting the “as found” conditions of submerged PG&E assets.

These inspections may include but are not limited to:

- Dams, Intake Towers, Grizzlies Trash Racks and Intake Screens, Spillways, Penstocks
Tunnels, Storage Tanks, Vaults, Adder-ways, Expansion Joints, Sealing Surfaces, Gates (radial, slide, drum)
Valves (slide, gate, sluice, butterfly, globe), Cables and chains, Operators, Control Shafts, Gears
Wheels, Paddles, Guides, Connecting hardware, Exposed piping (.50” to 16’ diameter). Bottom conditions (I.e. debris fields, sediment deposits and scour areas).

Repair tasks include, but are not limited to:

- Repair of damaged grizzlies or intake screens, Replacement of broken chains, inoperable shafts, seals, guides and joints, Replacement of valves, operators or gates, remediation of damaged concrete surfaces.
- These tasks may be accomplished using special concrete and epoxy compounds, neoprene rubber, wedge anchors, nuts/bolts/all-thread and or OEM replacement parts.

Maintenance tasks may include, but is not limited to:

- Rehabilitation of underwater steel surfaces, Replacing underwater hoses and piping, Servicing seal assemblies, sealing leaking stoplogs/gates/valves, Removal of crustacean growth and marine vegetation, Patches spalls in concrete surfaces, Clearing and removal of underwater debris, which impedes the operation of PG&E assets, Diver assisted hand dredging of mud, silt, gravel, and small rock

Construction activities may include, but is not limited to:

- Fabrication and installations of shaft guides, stoplog seals, grizzlies, valves, gates, guides, stops, operators, piping and concrete placement.
- Adding cover to existing pipelines with materials such as rock or native materials, pipeline installation of features such as clamps or other temporary pipeline repairs, installation or removal of pipeline anchors, and gas pipelines.
- Supporting Tower Demolition crews and Tower Foundation Building crews with barges that can support cranes and heavy equipment for delivery to islands and locations surrounded by water.

Requirements:

- **ISNetworld Registration:** Bidders must be registered with ISNetworld (ISN) and maintain a current safety rating of A or B throughout the duration of the contract.
- **Self-Performance Requirement:** Bidders must be a qualified Marine Contractor and are required to self-perform all work.
- **Labor Compliance:** Bidders must be union-affiliated or demonstrate compliance with prevailing wage requirements.

Supply Chain Responsibility Considerations:

The selected supplier is encouraged to align with PG&E’s Supply Chain Responsibility policies and procedures. The supplier will be asked to provide a detailed description of their internal, specific supply chain responsibility program and practices related to supplier diversity, environmental sustainability, and ethical business conduct.

Conduct Requirements:

Suppliers, as well as their employees, subcontractors, and sub-suppliers, must adhere to the principles and standards outlined in our Supplier Code of Conduct as they provide goods and services to PG&E. Review Code and understand its obligations here:
