Background:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, incorporated in California in 1905, is one of the largest utility companies in the United States. Based in Oakland, the company is part of [PG&E Corporation](#).

Contract Opportunity Description:

PG&E is seeking proposals for the implementation and continuous improvement of two existing programs—Tool Lending Library (TLL) and Induction Cooktop Loaner Program (ICLP).

The TLL loans energy measurement tools to customers and energy management professionals conducting energy efficiency, demand reduction, and electrification projects for buildings and facilities in California. The ICLP loans induction cooktops to PG&E customers seeking to try induction cooking. The Tool Lending Library (TLL) operates from the PG&E San Ramon Valley Conference Center and provides energy measurement, diagnostic, and monitoring equipment used for building audits, electrification studies, industrial and agricultural optimization commissioning, monitoring and verification, research, and training applications (www.pge.com/tools) The program supports third-party implementers for PG&E energy efficiency programs, designers, contractors, building operators, facility and plant managers, engineers, and residents by supplying tools that inform energy management decisions, validate performance, and help implement energy-saving projects. The TLL's operational framework includes inventory management for over 5,000 tools, providing technical support to borrowers for tool selection, preparing loans, processing returns, maintaining an equipment QA/QC program, providing borrower support, data tracking, reporting, and integration with WE&T training programs. The TLL provides loans to organizations and people working on projects throughout the State of California.

The Induction Cooktop Loaner Program (ICLP) provides PG&E residential and commercial food service customers opportunities to evaluate induction cooking technology in their own homes, businesses, and facilities. The program addresses key market barriers such as unfamiliarity with induction, providing hands-on trials through loaned induction cooktop kits. This program may operate from the contractor's approved place(s) of business, the PG&E San Ramon Valley Conference Center and/or the PG&E Stockton Conference Center or other locations approved by PG&E.

This RFP seeks a qualified contractor to operate both programs safely, efficiently, reliably, and in alignment with PG&E's performance and reporting requirements.
