#### Background:

PG&E service area stretches from Eureka in the north to Bakersfield in the south, and from the Pacific Ocean in the west to the Sierra Nevada in the east.

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**Contract Opportunity Description:**

The RFQ will cover landscaping services for PG&E facilities, as well as restoration work within landscaped areas at customer locations. **Vegetation management activities are not included in the scope of this event.**

In general, the Work entails Professional Landscaping services includes, but is not limited to, the following.

- Landscaping and Ground Maintenance
- Mowing and Fertilization
- Tree Care and Maintenance
- Hardscaped Areas Maintenance
- Irrigation System
- Landscape restoration
- Furnishing all labor, transportation, materials, tools, equipment, plants, vehicles, and supervision to perform landscape installation, repair and/or removal of plants and related services.
- Repair Work shall include cleanup of service area, replacement of plants and other similar work required to replace the landscape that has been damaged.
- Providing watering schedule for any watering required after the initial planting.
- Removing and Disposing of Spoils.
- Providing all traffic safety warning devices.

Contractors may propose covering part or all of the scope described above. There is no requirement for bidders to serve all regions.

This sourcing event aims to identify various suppliers within each region. Once PG&E has shortlisted at least five qualified suppliers per region, the supplier names will be shared with the relevant PG&E business functions for review and alignment.

All awarded bidders will enter a contract with PG&E. Contract award is contingent upon successful registering in ISN and achieving an A or B grade.

**Conduct Requirements:**
