## **Attachment 1, Certified-Interoperable Customer-Owned Telemetry Vendors**

PG&E has tested and certified the following customer-owned telemetry (COT) vendors for interoperability with PG&E's Common Smart Inverter Profile (CSIP)-certified IEEE 2030.5 solution.

The list of certified-interoperable vendors is expected to expand as PG&E continues to work with vendors to provide COT solutions. Interconnection customers (ICs) are free to select other vendors; however, new solutions require testing and configuration for interoperability with PG&E's CSIP-certified IEEE 2030.5 headend server, which can result in additional time and costs for the IC.
