In Progress Programmatic Permits:

1. City of Tiburon-initial conversations have taken place. City aiming for 1/2022 start.
2. County of Santa Clara-meeting to be set to review permit draft over next couple of weeks
3. City of Oakley-pre-engagement meeting took place first week of September to introduce the programmatic permit.
4. City of Mountain View-reviewed draft programmatic permit with agency. Setting next meeting to address questions and agency feedback
5. City of Hollister-meeting set September 13th to have initial programmatic conversation
6. City of Santa Rosa- reviewed draft, city looking to entertain soon after they work through items more pressing on their side.

EPWC is currently engaging multiple jurisdictions on a regular basis on programmatic encroachment permit interest.

Lessons learned from programmatic permits:

Programmatic permits have provided a clear strategy for both the Agencies and PG&E to process the substantial amount of work within a short cycle time. These agreements have also allowed us to help address the resource shortfall with many of these Agencies, by creating a process that bypasses individual permit submittals.
