



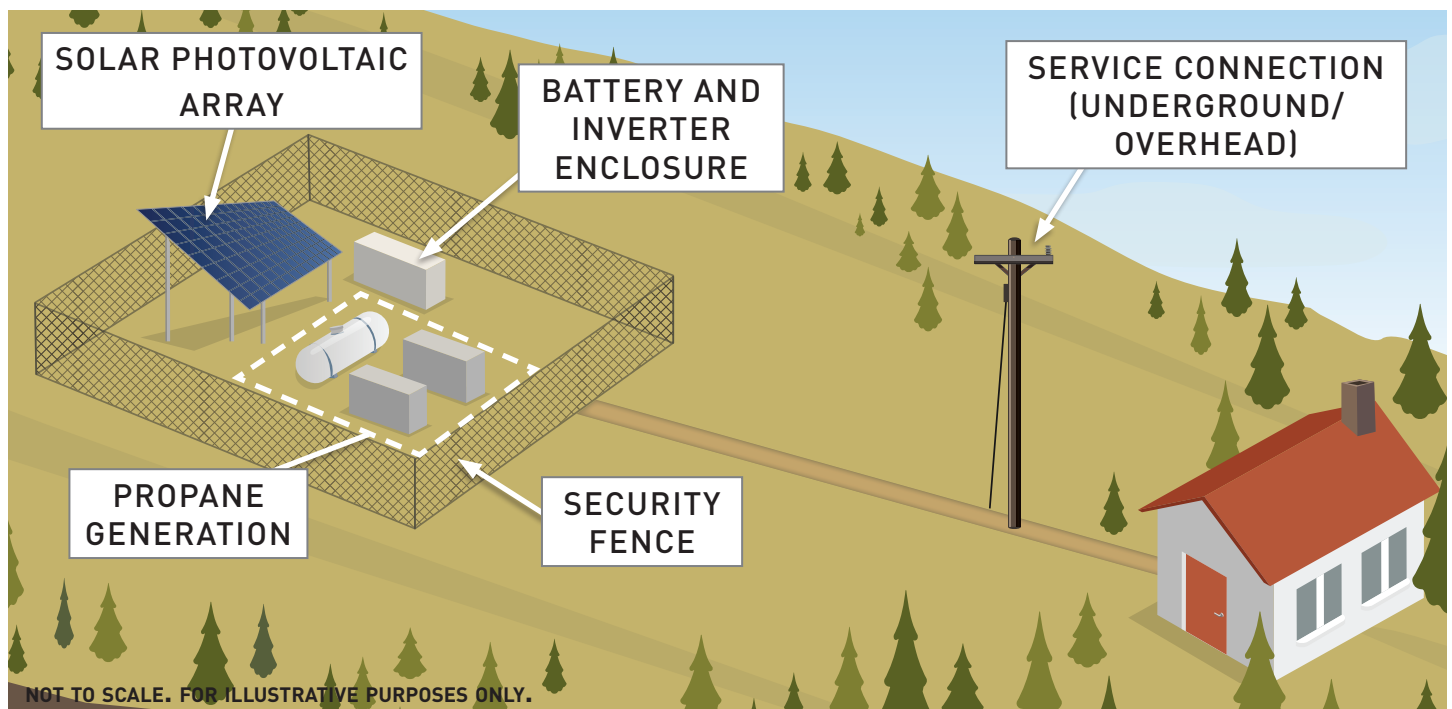

## Remote Grids: A New Way of Receiving Power

We continue to strengthen our electric system for the safety of our customers and communities. This includes building Remote Grids in high fire-threat areas to provide eligible customers with safe and reliable electric service.

### What is a Remote Grid?

Remote Grids are standalone power systems that are independent of the electric grid. They use a combination of solar, batteries and fuel-powered generation to provide continuous electricity.



### Benefits of Participating in the Remote Grid Program

- ✔ Reduction of wildfire risk by removing electric poles and wires.
- ✔ Equal or improved quality and level of service.
- ✔ Fewer service interruptions during winter weather or Public Safety Power Shutoffs.

## Remote Grid Design

We work closely with property owners to design the remote grid to suit the unique needs of each location. We also:

- Review site specifics, defensible space and remote grid site requirements to choose a location in partnership with the property owner.
- Install fencing approximately 10 feet tall around the system for safety and security.
- Maintain the standalone power system and surrounding defensible space year-round.



## How Will Participating Customers Be Compensated?

Along with paying all installation and maintenance costs, PG&E will provide participants in the program compensation, which may include:

- Early participant cash incentive
- Property easement payment (for property owners hosting the system)

### Does this Change PG&E Energy Bills or Rates?

Program participants will have no change to existing PG&E billing or energy rates, and eligible customers may continue to choose from available rate schedules.
