Former Hollister Manufactured Gas Plant Sally and Sixth Streets, Hollister, CA Field Work Scheduled for February 25 – March 8, 2013

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform the community about field work that Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) will be conducting at and around the Hollister former manufactured gas plant located at Sally and Sixth Streets in Hollister, California. PG&E contractors, under the oversight of DTSC, will collect soil samples to assist in the design of a plan to cleanup soils impacted with former gas plant residues including polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) and metals.

Work Planned: Field work be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. and includes the following:

- Temporarily blocking off sampling areas;
- Identifying underground piping and utilities;
- Drilling holes through concrete and asphalt with hand equipment and a truck-mounted drill rig to collect soil and groundwater samples;
- Cataloging samples for laboratory testing; and
- Backfilling holes and general cleanup.

Soil samples will be collected from the Service Center and the sidewalk areas at Sixth, Sally, and Seventh Streets adjacent to the Service Center. There will be no impacts to area traffic but during the work pedestrians using the sidewalks may be detoured to the opposite side of the street.
