

SANTA CRUZ FORMER MANUFACTURED GAS PLANT

Environmental Restoration Project | Parking Information - Fall 2012

From August to January 2013, PG&E and Chevron Environmental Management Company (Chevron) will conduct a voluntary environmental restoration project in and around commercial properties located at the southwest corner of River Street and North Pacific Avenue. The work involves excavating soils that contain old gas plant residues; backfilling these areas with clean fill material; repaving parking lots; and landscaping around the parking lots, buildings, and exterior areas of the site.

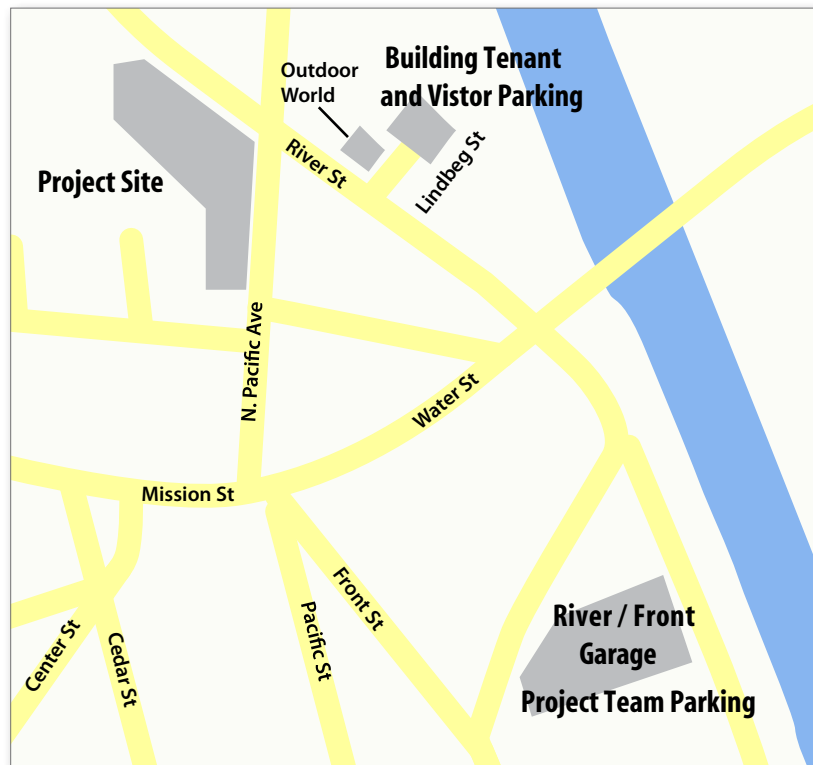
The work will be conducted in phases and at certain times building tenants will not have access to the parking lots in which they normally park. During these times we have arranged for alternate parking as shown on the map below.

Tenant Parking: Displaced tenants and their clients can park at 110 Lindberg Street (behind Outdoor World). This parking lot will be open from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. An on-site monitor will help with parking and will provide directions to your place of business for clients and visitors.

Project Team: Project team members are required to park at the River/Front Street garage located next to the Galleria office complex.
