

POSTING REQUIREMENTS FOR FERC STANDARDS OF CONDUCT
PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

FERC Standards of Conduct, Section 358.7(a): If a transmission provider discloses non-public transmission function information, other than information identified in paragraph (a)(2) of this section, in a manner contrary to the requirements of § 358.6, the transmission provider must immediately post the information that was disclosed on its Internet website.

In preparation for a potential Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) event that is forecasted to commence on 9/23/2019 at 2000, on 9/21/2019 Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) notified potentially affected customers that the transmission lines identified below may be de-energized during the PSPS event.
