

POSTING REQUIREMENTS FOR FERC STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

FERC Standards of Conduct, Section 358.7(i): A transmission provider must post on its Internet website notice of each waiver of a tariff provision that it grants in favor of an affiliate, unless such waiver has been approved by the Commission. The posting must be made within one business day of the act of a waiver. The transmission provider must also maintain a log of the acts of waiver, and must make it available to the Commission upon request. The records must be kept for a period of five years from the date of each act of waiver.

This provision is largely inapplicable to PG&E. PG&E has transferred operational control of its transmission system to the California Independent System Operation Corporation (CAISO). As a Participating Transmission Owner of the CAISO, PG&E has access to certain transmission information but does not control access to or control the provision of transmission service on the interstate grid. The CAISO has the obligation to provide open access to the transmission system in a non-discriminating manner under the CAISO tariff.
