A home heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) system accounts for up to 44 percent of a typical home energy bill. Your HVAC system is complex, and needs regular maintenance, just like your car. In fact, twice a year maintenance for your HVAC system can help achieve efficiency and help achieve its potential life span.

Did you know that a properly maintained system is more effective at helping you manage costs and comfort? That's because your system will perform more efficiently and may be less likely to break down over time.

Now, there's a new program from PG&E that offers you rebates for giving your HVAC system the maintenance it needs to work its best. It's the AC Quality Care Rebate Program.



How this program works

The AC Quality Care Rebate Program is based on a nationally-recognized industry maintenance standard and the latest technology. To participate, contractors must meet the rigorous criteria that PG&E requires for the AC Quality Care program.

AC Quality Care begins with a comprehensive system assessment to give you a complete picture— from equipment safety to performance to necessary repairs. A participating contractor will:

- Spend an hour or more at your home going over how your system is working, and what you can expect from the program
- Complete a detailed system assessment, including a combustion safety evaluation of natural gas appliances
- Provide you with a detailed evaluation and recommendations, along with information about qualifying for rebates

You decide what work, if any, you want to have your contractor perform. Once the work has been completed, your participating contractor will help you apply for PG&E rebates to offset your costs.



How to qualify for rebates

To save you money and to help your HVAC system run more efficiently, PG&E is offering rebates to offset your costs for the following services:

- **\$50 Initial HVAC System Inventory and Assessment Rebate**, which provides you with a comprehensive evaluation of your system, so you can work with your contractor on next steps. Following this assessment, you may qualify for the rebates listed below.
- **\$250 Airflow Correction Rebate**, to adjust, repair, and renovate ducts, and install new filters
- **\$50 Refrigeration System Service Rebate**, which includes faults diagnosis and correction of refrigerant charge levels
- **\$150 High-Efficiency Blower Motor Retrofit Rebate**
- **\$50 One-Year Quality Maintenance Service Agreement Rebate**

Rebates are available only for work done by participating contractors. You must have a central forced air conditioner or heat pump, and get your electricity from PG&E. And you must live in a single-family residence or duplex in climate zone with hot summers (Climate Zones 2, 4, 11, 12, 13, and 16). To determine your zone, go to www.pge.com/climatezone and enter your zip code.
