



Colusa Service Center Environmental Activities Update January 2013

Introduction

PG&E is distributing this work notice to update the community on environmental cleanup work being conducted at the Colusa Service Center site.

Planned Activities and Schedule

From January 7 to January 9th, PG&E will be performing excavation, backfill, compaction and paving work within a one-block portion of 1st Street located between Market and Main Streets. We anticipate the street will only be closed for this period; however, this is dependent on weather. This section of the street will be closed to through traffic and pedestrians while we perform the following work:

January 7 – 8, 2013

- 1st Street closed during day and night
- Excavation and backfill activities
- Pour curb and gutter on the west side of 1st Street

January 9, 2013

- 1st Street closed during day
- Street paving and striping
- Reopen street at the end of the day

What You Can Expect

The portion of 1st Street between Market and Main will be closed to traffic and pedestrians from Monday, January 7 to Wednesday January 9.

Area residents can expect to hear heavy equipment noise during this work and feel vibrations related to compaction of soil. Compaction work is necessary to make sure that the soil will support road base/asphalt, and curbs and gutters.
