

WORK NOTICE



Former Manufactured Gas Plant 811 West J Street Oakdale, California October 2009



Field Work Scheduled for October 27 to October 28, 2009

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform the community about upcoming field work at Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) Oakdale Service Center (site) located at 811 West J Street in Oakdale, California. From 1913 to 1930, a manufactured gas plant operated on the site. During the past year, PG&E's contractors collected soil, soil gas, and groundwater samples from various locations on- and off-site; sample results indicated that residues from past gas manufacturing operations are present in some areas on, and immediately adjacent to, the site. For the upcoming field work, PG&E contractors, under the oversight of DTSC, plan to collect additional samples of soil to complete the site investigation. The data gathered will help determine the extent of cleanup that will be necessary.

Work will take place Tuesday, October 27th and Wednesday, October 28th between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. and includes the following:

- About 10 holes will be drilled at various locations adjacent to the site including the street in front of the site. Soil samples will be collected using hand sampling equipment and a truck-mounted drill rig.
- Boreholes will be filled with a concrete mixture and patched with asphalt or concrete after work is completed.
- All work will be conducted in accordance with a site Health and Safety Plan. Workers may wear safety gear while working on-site and operating heavy equipment

The work will take place within areas immediately adjacent to the site. Five borings will be drilled in West J Street in front of the site. During the street drilling activities, pedestrian traffic and on-street parking will be detoured to the opposite side of the street and traffic control measures will be used.
