



# WORK NOTICE

Former Manufactured Gas Plant

## Field Work being conducted beginning the week of July 7, 2008

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) wants to inform you about upcoming work to be performed as part of a site investigation at the Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) Tracy Service Center (site) located at 502 East Grant Line Road in Tracy, California. The site, which once contained a manufactured gas plant, is shown on the map on the reverse side of this work notice. PG&E contractors, under the oversight of DTSC, plan to begin collecting samples of soil, soil gas and groundwater throughout the site. These samples are being collected as part of a phased site investigation that will determine if residues from past gas manufacturing operations are present in soil and groundwater at the site.

Work will take place from about July 7<sup>th</sup> through July 18<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. and includes the following:

- ✦ Approximately 30 holes will be drilled through concrete and asphalt paving and soil and soil gas samples will be collected using sampling equipment and a truck-mounted drill rig from various locations on-site. One groundwater monitoring well will be installed and four existing monitoring wells will be sampled.
- ✦ Boreholes will be filled with a concrete mixture and patched with asphalt or concrete after work is completed.
- ✦ For their own protection, workers may wear safety gear while working on-site and operating heavy equipment.

All work will be conducted in accordance with a site-specific Health and Safety Plan. Soil, soil gas, and groundwater samples will be analyzed for one or more of the following constituents: polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, heavy metals, petroleum hydrocarbons and volatile organic compounds.

This work will be completed in accordance with the Final Remedial Investigation Workplan for the site. This document and a complete record of the site can be found at:

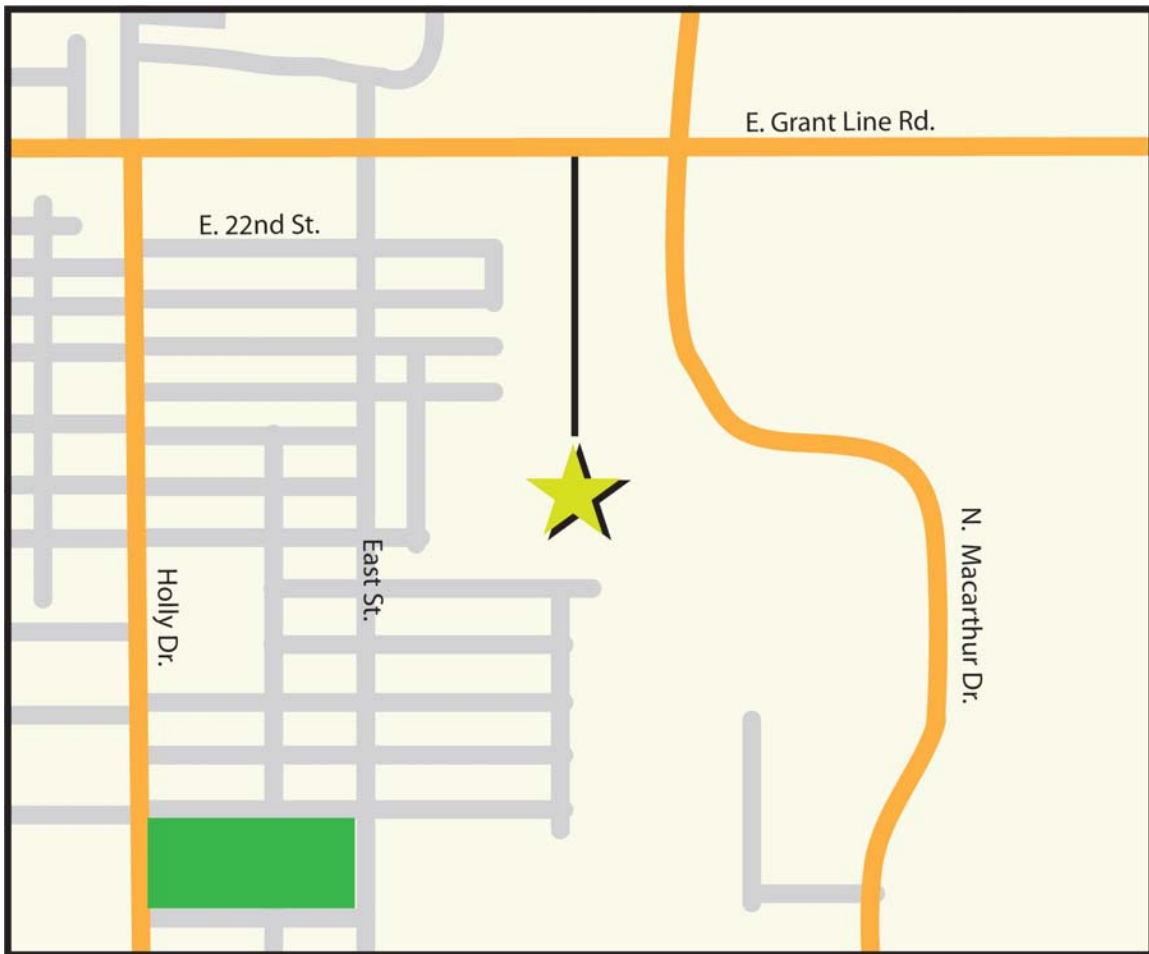
