



# WORK NOTICE CONFIRMATION SAMPLING

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform interested community members that PG&E will be conducting field work consisting of environmental sampling, testing and well installation at the Watsonville General Construction Yard and Service Center sites. This sampling work is being done to evaluate site conditions following the completion of cleanup activities.

The following activities will take place during field work:

- From February 2<sup>nd</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup>, contractors will be on-site and will be using heavy machinery to drill holes in various areas of the asphalt in the General Construction Yard.
- During the week of February 13<sup>th</sup>, contractors will collect samples from the borehole locations.
- The scheduled activities may be changed due to weather, but it is anticipated that the work will be complete by the end of February.

Work will take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, but workers may arrive on-site as early as 6:30 a.m. to set up for field activities. You may hear noise and vibrations that are typical of general construction work.
