



# WORK NOTICE CONFIRMATION SAMPLING

**April 30 – May 25, 2012**



## **PG&E General Construction Yard Site 14 Walker Street Watsonville, California**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform interested community members that PG&E will be conducting field work consisting of environmental sampling, testing, and well installation at the Watsonville General Construction Yard site. This sampling work is being done to evaluate site conditions following the completion of cleanup activities.

The following activities will take place during field work:

- From April 30<sup>th</sup> through May 15<sup>th</sup>, contractors will be on-site using heavy machinery to drill holes in various areas of the asphalt in the General Construction Yard to install groundwater monitoring wells.
- From May 16<sup>th</sup> through May 21<sup>st</sup>, contractors will be on-site to develop the three new groundwater monitoring wells at the General Construction Yard.
- From May 22<sup>nd</sup> through May 25<sup>th</sup>, groundwater samples will be collected from the three groundwater wells.
- The schedule activities may be changed based on permitting and actual production, but it is anticipated that the work will be complete by the end of May.

Work will take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, but workers may arrive on-site as early as 6:30 a.m. to set-up for field activities. You may hear noise and vibrations that are typical of general construction work.
