



WORK NOTICE CONFIRMATION SAMPLING



June 6 – June 30, 2011

PG&E General Construction Yard and Service Center Sites 11 and 14 Walker Street Watsonville, California

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform interested community members that PG&E will be conducting field work consisting of environmental sampling, testing and well installation at the Watsonville General Construction Yard and Service Center sites. This sampling work is being done to evaluate site conditions following the completion of cleanup activities.

The following activities will take place during field work:

- During the week of June 6th, one borehole will be drilled through asphalt and soil by a truck-mounted drill rig at the General Construction Yard. Also during this week three boreholes will be drilled through asphalt and soil using a truck-mounted drill rig to construct three groundwater wells at the Service Center. Additionally, some work will be conducted at an existing well located in the Pajaro River levee immediately south of the Service Center.
- During the week of June 13th, 15 boreholes will be drilled through asphalt and soil by a truck-mounted drill rig to construct soil gas probes at the General Construction Yard. Also during this week groundwater samples will be collected from the groundwater wells at the Service Center property and one well located on the levee.
- During the week of June 20th, soil gas samples will be collected from the 15 probes at the General Construction Yard.
- During the week of June 27th, the 15 soil gas boreholes will be removed at the General Construction Yard.

Work will take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, but workers may arrive on-site as early as 6:30 a.m. to set-up for field activities. You may hear noise and vibrations that are typical of general construction work.
