



WORK NOTICE



Former Manufactured Gas Plant
Colusa, California
July 2011

Field work scheduled from July 7 through July 29, 2011

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this work notice to inform the community that Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) will be performing field work in and around 105 Second Street (Site) in Colusa, California. From 1886 to about 1940, a manufactured gas plant (MGP) operated at the Site. DTSC has recently approved a cleanup plan for this Site and PG&E contractors, under the oversight of DTSC, will be conducting additional sampling work to help with the design of a plan to clean up old gas plant residues in soil. Samples will be collected both on- and off-site, including the alleyway, streets and sidewalks surrounding the site.

Work will take place between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. from July 7 to July 29, 2011, and includes the following:

Activity	What you can expect to see
July 7 – 8: Underground utility location	Workers using hand-held equipment surveying the area in and around the Site to locate underground utilities, and spray painting markings on the ground to identify areas with underground utilities.
July 19 – 25: 104 soil borings will be placed on the site and in the sidewalks, streets and the alleyway located next to the Site.	A variety of equipment will be used to drill borings into the ground at depths from 5 to 40 feet. These include hand-augurs and the use of a truck with specially mounted boring equipment. Samples will be sent to a lab for testing of MGP residues.
July 26 – 29: Previously installed groundwater monitoring well will be removed.	Workers will be on-site with a drill rig to remove the well casing and related materials. The borehole will be filled in with grout and any related waste will be disposed of off-site.

All work will be conducted in accordance with a Health and Safety Plan. An environmental project manager will also be on-site to monitor field work. Gas lines in the area have been identified and precautions will be taken by workers so that they are not disturbed.
