

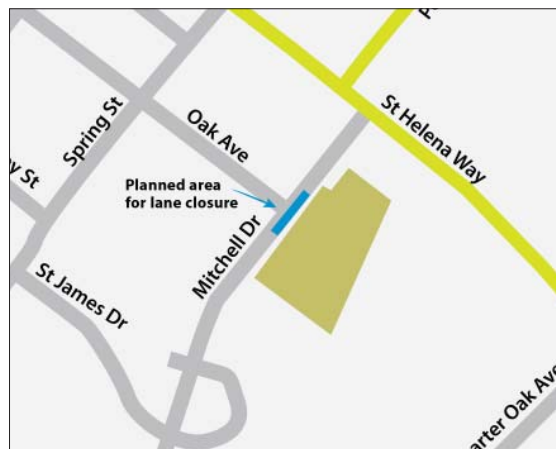
# NOTICE OF TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURE at 1300 block of Mitchell Drive January 4 – 21, 2011

DTSC will oversee this work. Mitchell Drive will still remain open, and traffic control will be provided to monitor and direct traffic through the construction work area.
