## Soil Removal Work at PG&E's General Construction Yard Site is 100% Complete

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this work notice to update the community on cleanup work being conducted at the Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) General Construction (GC) Yard site located at 14 Walker Street in Watsonville.

Soil removal and cleanup work at the GC Yard is finished. DTSC anticipates that site restoration and all other remaining project work will be completed by late-March. Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and will include the following:

- Grading the new clean fill material and paving the entire site with asphalt and concrete. You may periodically feel vibrations from the grading and compaction activities.
- Removing the sound barrier fence and restoring the shoulder along West Front Street with a curb and gutter system and constructing a driveway into the alley from West Front Street.
- Removing from the site construction equipment that will no longer be needed. The 10-foot temporary fence extension which runs the length of the site next to the alley has been removed to access the area that needs to be paved. The existing 6-foot fence and privacy screening is still in place.
- Taking samples of soil from a few off-site areas to determine if any pockets of contaminated soil remain. Depending on the results of soil sampling, some very small spot soil removal may be conducted in off-site areas.

**Community Protection Measures:** To protect public safety and to minimize dust, the following actions will be taken during site restoration work:

- Watering work areas to control dust
- Maintaining slow speed of construction vehicles
- Maintaining wind screens on perimeter fences
- Limiting the number of trucks entering and exiting the site
- Brushing truck tires to remove soil, if necessary
- Sweeping streets surrounding the site daily.
