



NOTICE OF COMPLETION SOIL CLEANUP PROJECT



September 2010

PG&E General Construction Yard Site – 14 Walker Street Watsonville, California

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform interested community members that soil cleanup work is finished at Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) Watsonville General Construction Yard site.

Cleanup activities included the following:

- removal of various on-site debris;
- excavation of contaminated soil to depths ranging from 3 to 21 feet ;
- off-site disposal at a permitted landfill facility of 14,000 cubic yards (about 900 truckloads);
- restoration of the site to its original grade;
- paving or landscaping of the entire site; and
- construction of a concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter along the Front Street shoulder immediately in front of the site.

Air monitoring was also conducted throughout the entire project and the levels of dust did not go over the allowable levels. The work was conducted in a manner that was safe for on-site workers, nearby residents and business workers. This fall, PG&E's environmental consultants will prepare a Closure Report which will document the cleanup efforts. Upon approval of the report, DTSC will issue a Certificate of Completion.
