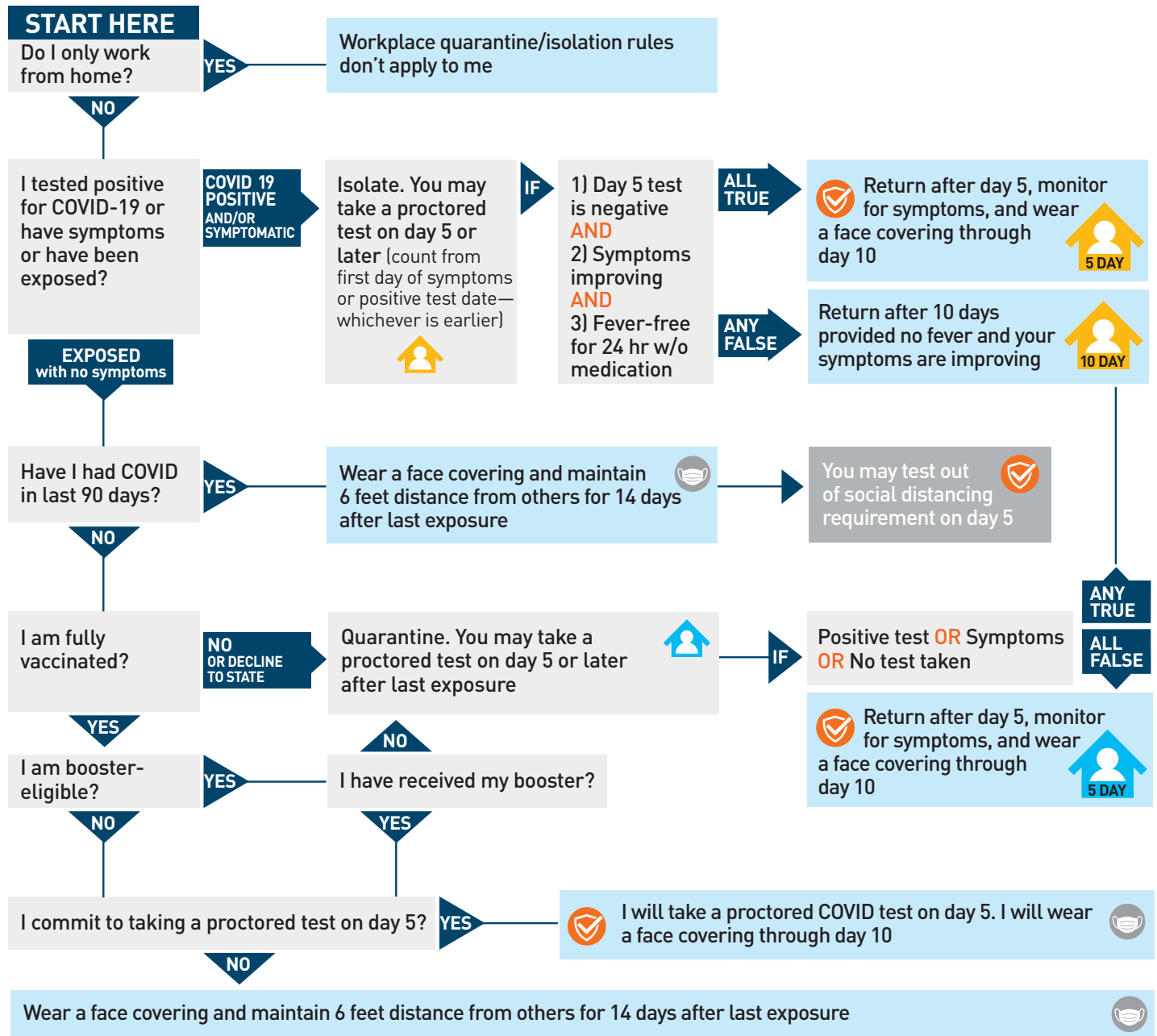


Cal/OSHA rules for Quarantine and Isolation

Need evidence of test emailed:

Proctored test means:

- An **antigen test** performed by a clinic or observed and documented by an approved telehealth provider (**preferred**)
- A laboratory (**PCR**) test
- A home test that includes digital results with date and time stamp through an **app**

Not permitted:

At home tests where you take the sample and read the results (e.g., most over-the-counter kits) without a digital result through an app.

Booster Eligible:

Pfizer/Moderna: 5 months after second shot
Johnson & Johnson: 2 months after receiving shot

In the event exposure is continuous (e.g. an individual in your household that you can't isolate from), the date of last exposure is **10 days after the individual's positive COVID test or the onset of their symptoms whichever is earlier.**

*Quarantine is a strategy used to prevent transmission of COVID-19 by keeping people who have been in close contact with someone with COVID-19 apart from others.
**Isolation is used to separate people with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 from those without COVID-19.
