Dear Community Member:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of an environmental cleanup project in your area and invite you to participate in the enclosed community survey. The California Department of Toxic Substances Control is the regulatory agency providing oversight of the investigation and cleanup activities for the former PG&E Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) in Napa. The Site is located at the corner of Riverside Drive and Elm Street in Napa, California 94559.

From 2010 to 2016, PG&E conducted environmental investigations to determine the extent of contamination in soil, soil gas (air in between particles), and groundwater at the Site. Investigations found the following chemicals of concern: total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH), volatile organic compounds (VOCs), polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs), cyanide, polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), arsenic, and lead in soil; VOCs in soil gas; and TPH, PAHs, arsenic, methylene chloride, thallium, and sulfate in groundwater.

We are currently reviewing possible cleanup options. We will be inviting your comments after we complete our review. You will receive a Community Update that announces the public comment period for a draft cleanup plan. We will be hosting a public meeting so we can hear your input. We value public involvement in selecting the best possible remedy.

Thank you for taking the time to complete the community survey. Your response will help us determine the level of community interest in the cleanup process. Please return the survey by **October 29, 2018**.
