



Pacific Gas and Electric Company Potrero Site Cleanup Project Weekly Activity Report 7/28/17

This report provides an update on the status of cleanup work in the Northeast Area of the former power plant located at 1201 Illinois Street. Cleanup work is being performed as part of a company-wide program to address sites that have been impacted by historic operations. Project oversight is provided by the San Francisco Bay Region Water Quality Control Board and the city/county of San Francisco.

Work Completed 7/24/17 to 7/28/17

- Continued to prepare the area that will be used to stockpile soil
- Installed the scaffolding to be used in support of truck loading operations
- Continued to install the storm water management system
- Began to excavate and stockpile soil to prepare for installation of steel sheet piles

Work Planned for Upcoming Week

- Continue to receive material and equipment deliveries
- Install the scale and cleaning station to be used in support of truck loading operations
- Continue to excavate soil to prepare for installation of steel sheet piles
- Begin hauling soil off-site to a licensed disposal facility

Air Monitoring

- Air monitoring confirmed that air quality remained at levels protective of the health of on-site workers and the surrounding community
- Workers are wearing respirators per safety requirements until air monitoring data confirms respirators are not needed

Work Hours

- 7 A.M. to 8 P.M., Monday through Friday; work will also occur on Saturday, 7/29 and possibly Sunday, 7/30 during these hours

Anticipated Impacts

- Minimal impacts are expected beyond continued deliveries and transportation

Site Security

- On-site security is present at the site and access gates are closed to the public at all times
