



# Pacific Gas and Electric Company Potrero Site Cleanup Project Weekly Activity Report 8/18/17

This report provides an update on the status of cleanup work in the Northeast Area of the former power plant located at 1201 Illinois Street. Cleanup work is being performed as part of a company-wide program to address sites that have been impacted by historic operations. Project oversight is provided by the San Francisco Bay Region Water Quality Control Board and the city/county of San Francisco.

## Work Completed 8/14/17 to 8/18/17

- Continued excavating soil next to the seawall and in the northern end of the project site, and transporting it to a licensed off-site disposal facility
- Removed metal debris encountered below ground as part of excavation work
- Removed interior fencing and a storage area no longer in use
- Continued to remove underground utility lines no longer in use

## Work Planned for Upcoming Week

- Begin installing steel sheet piles near the shoreline to build a new seawall
- Continue removing underground utility lines no longer in use
- Continue relocating underground utilities in the area where soil will be treated below-ground
- Continue soil excavation work in support of work described and transport soil to a licensed off-site disposal facility

## Air Monitoring

- Air monitoring confirmed that air quality remained at levels protective of the health of the surrounding community
- Workers may wear respirators per safety requirements when starting work in a new area until air data confirms they are not required

---

## Work Hours

- 7 A.M. to 8 P.M., Monday through Friday; work may occur on Saturday 8/19 during these hours

---

## Anticipated Impacts

- Vibrations may be felt by nearby neighbors next week while the steel sheet piles are being installed to build a new seawall
- Sheet piles will be installed using specialized equipment that minimizes noise, but an impact hammer may be used if needed

## Site Security

- Site security is provided at the site and the access gates are closed to the public at all times
