



Pacific Gas and Electric Company Potrero Site Cleanup Project Weekly Activity Report 8/25/17

This report provides an update on the status of cleanup work in the Northeast Area of the former power plant located at 1201 Illinois Street. Cleanup work is being performed as part of a company-wide program to address sites that have been impacted by historic operations. Project oversight is provided by the San Francisco Bay Region Water Quality Control Board and the city/county of San Francisco.

Work Completed 8/22/17 to 8/25/17

- Continued excavating soil next to the seawall and in the northern end of the project site
- Removed metal debris and concrete encountered below ground as part of excavation work
- Removed a storage area no longer in use, including its foundation
- Continued to remove underground utility lines no longer in use

Work Planned for Upcoming Week

- Remove concrete below ground near the shoreline
- Continue removing underground utility lines no longer in use
- Continue relocating underground utilities in the area where soil will be treated below ground
- Continue excavating soil next to the seawall and in the northern end of the project site
- Transport excavated soil to a licensed off-site disposal facility

Air Monitoring

- Air monitoring confirmed that air quality remained at levels protective of the health of the surrounding community
- Workers may wear respirators per safety requirements when starting work in a new area until air data confirms they are not required

Work Hours

- 7 A.M. to 8 P.M., Monday through Friday

Anticipated Impacts

- Minimal impacts are expected beyond continued deliveries and trucking activities

Site Security

- Site security is provided at the site and the access gates are closed to the public at all times
