



Pacific Gas and Electric Company Potrero Site Cleanup Project Weekly Activity Report 10/6/17

This report provides an update on the status of cleanup work in the Northeast Area of the former power plant located at 1201 Illinois Street. Cleanup work is being performed as part of a company-wide program to address sites that have been impacted by historic operations. Project oversight is provided by the San Francisco Bay Region Water Quality Control Board and the city/county of San Francisco.

Work Completed 10/2/17 to 10/6/17

- Completed installation of the surface water management system
- Continued pulling wood pile remnants found in soil below ground
- Excavated debris and soil, and transported it to a licensed off-site disposal facility
- Removed buried piping in the area where soil treatment will occur

Work Planned for Upcoming Week

- Continue pulling wood pile remnants found in soil below ground
- Install steel sheeting along the shoreline
- Continue excavating and transporting soil/debris to a licensed off-site disposal facility

Air Monitoring

- Air monitoring confirmed that air quality remained at levels protective of the health of the surrounding community

Work Hours

- 7 A.M. to 8 P.M., Monday through Saturday, 10/7

Anticipated Impacts

- Deliveries of construction materials and other trucking activities may cause minor traffic impacts
- Vibrations may be felt in areas close to the site during installation of steel sheet piles associated with building a new seawall

Site Security

- On-site security is present at the site after hours and the access gates are closed to the public at all times
