



# Pacific Gas and Electric Company Potrero Site Cleanup Project Weekly Activity Report 10/13/17

This report provides an update on the status of cleanup work in the Northeast Area of the former power plant located at 1201 Illinois Street. Cleanup work is being performed as part of a company-wide program to address sites that have been impacted by historic operations. Project oversight is provided by the San Francisco Bay Region Water Quality Control Board and the city/county of San Francisco.

## Work Completed 10/9/17 to 10/13/17

- Continued removing wood pile remnants found in soil below ground
- Removed buried utilities in the treatment area
- Completed the storm water management system
- Excavated debris and soil, and transported it to a licensed off-site disposal facility
- Installed steel sheeting along the shoreline

---

## Work Planned for Upcoming Week

- Continue removing wood pile remnants found in soil below ground
- Continue excavating and transporting debris and soil to a licensed off-site disposal facility

---

## Air Monitoring

- Air monitoring confirmed that air quality remained at levels protective of the health of the surrounding community

---

## Work Hours

- 7 A.M. to 8 P.M., Monday through Friday

---

## Anticipated Impacts

- Deliveries of construction materials and other trucking activities may cause minor traffic impacts
- Noise and vibrations may be felt in areas close to the site during installation of steel sheet piles associated with building a new seawall

## Site Security

- On-site security is present at the site after hours and the access gates are closed to the public at all times
