



Pacific Gas and Electric Company Potrero Site Cleanup Project Weekly Activity Report 11/3/17

This report provides an update on the status of cleanup work at the former power plant located at 1201 Illinois Street. Cleanup work is being performed as part of a company-wide program to address sites that have been impacted by historic operations. Project oversight is provided by the San Francisco Bay Region Water Quality Control Board and the city/county of San Francisco.

Work Completed 10/30/17 to 11/3/17

- Continued removing wood pile remnants found in soil below ground and removing buried utilities in the soil treatment area.
- Continued abandoning buried and above ground utilities in the treatment area.
- Continued excavating debris and soil, and transported them to a licensed off-site disposal facility.

Work Planned for Upcoming Week – Work Begins in Tank Farm Area

In addition to continuing work in the Northeast Area, for the next four to five weeks PG&E will be investigating soil and groundwater in the former Tank Farm Area, now that the former above ground oil storage tanks are removed. Workers will use hand tools, backhoes, and truck-mounted drill rigs to collect samples. Additional sampling in the Tank Farm Area will likely take place in early 2018. This investigation work will determine if cleanup is needed in the area, and help keep redevelopment efforts on schedule. A report with findings, and future cleanup plans, will be shared with the community.

Safety and Air Monitoring

- Air monitoring confirmed that air quality remained at levels protective of the health of the surrounding community.
- All work is done in accordance with a site-specific Health and Safety Plan that meets state and federal standards.

Work Hours

- 7 A.M. to 8 P.M., Monday through Friday.

Anticipated Impacts

- Deliveries of construction materials and other trucking activities may cause minor traffic impacts.
- Trucks will use approved routes, avoid residential areas, and not park off-site to minimize impacts.

Site Security

- On-site security is present at the site after hours and the access gates are closed to the public at all times.
