



# Pacific Gas and Electric Company Potrero Site Cleanup Project Weekly Activity Report 12/8/17

PG&E is slowing down and stopping activities for the next couple of weeks at the former power plant located at 1201 Illinois Street. This will be the last community update issued until work resumes in January 2018. Cleanup work is being performed as part of a company-wide program to address sites that have been impacted by historic operations. Project oversight is provided by the San Francisco Bay Region Water Quality Control Board and the city/county of San Francisco.

## Work Completed 12/4/17 to 12/8/17

- Continued excavating, transporting, and disposing of debris and soil in preparation for below ground soil treatment.
- Continued collecting soil and groundwater samples in the Tank Farm Area.
- Began demobilizing equipment and securing the site for a break in work activities.

---

## Upcoming Work

- Finish demobilizing equipment and securing the site over the next few weeks.
- Continue collecting soil and groundwater samples in the Tank Farm Area.
- We anticipate work at the site will resume in January 2018 and update reports will continue at that time.

---

## Safety and Air Monitoring

- Air monitoring confirmed that air quality remained at levels protective of the health of the surrounding community.
- All work is done in accordance with a site-specific Health and Safety Plan that meets state and federal standards.

## Work Hours

- 7 A.M. to 8 P.M., Monday through Friday.

## Anticipated Impacts

- Deliveries of construction materials and other trucking activities may cause minor traffic impacts.
- Trucks will use approved routes, avoid residential areas, and not park off-site to minimize impacts.

## Site Security

- On-site security is present at the site after hours and the access gates are closed to the public at all times.
