

# DTSC WORK NOTICE

**Department of Toxic Substances Control** – Our mission is to protect the people, communities, and environment of California from harmful chemicals by cleaning up contaminated sites, enforcing hazardous waste laws, and compelling the development of safer products.

## **PG&E Former Manufactured Gas Plants (MGPs) Marina District and Fisherman’s Wharf, San Francisco**

### **Soil, Soil Vapor, and Groundwater Sampling: *February 1, 2022 through January 31, 2023***

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) oversees a program to sample and, where necessary, clean up former manufactured gas plant (MGP) sites that PG&E historically owned or operated. MGPs produced gas from coal and oil before natural gas was readily available.

#### **What is the work?**

- Drill temporary soil borings, collect soil vapor samples, and groundwater samples to further characterize soil, soil vapor and groundwater conditions (see sampling areas on page 2).
- Sampling will involve workers using handheld equipment (e.g., hand augers, probes), mobile testing equipment and drilling equipment such as truck mounted drill rigs.
- Continue to collect groundwater samples from existing monitoring wells (see existing monitoring well locations on page 2).

***Please note: Groundwater in these areas is not used as a drinking water source. Drinking water is provided by the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission.***

#### **When will you see the work?**

- This work is expected to occur intermittently from **February 1, 2022 through January 31, 2023**.
- Work will take place on weekdays between the hours of **8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.**

#### **How will the work impact you?**

- Portions of sidewalks, parking spaces and open space areas may be temporarily blocked off so that work can be conducted safely.
- There will be temporary noise impacts from drilling; work will be conducted according to the San Francisco Noise Control Ordinance. 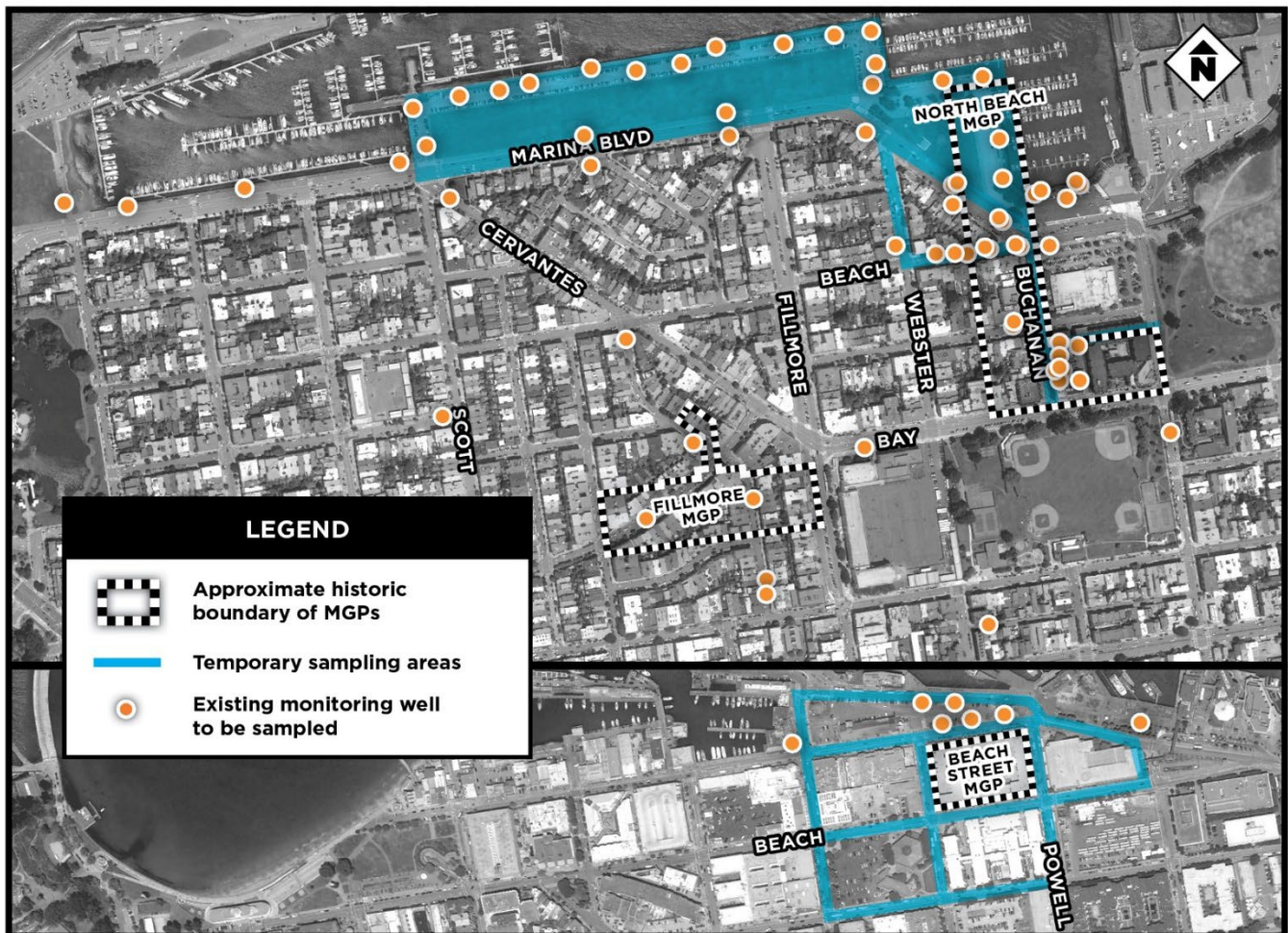
