Soil Excavation Associated with Sub-Station Upgrades: May 7, 2018 through November 30, 2018

What is the work?

- Excavating soil contaminated with polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) from former manufactured gas plant operations.
- Soil excavation for sub-station upgrades (utilities, driveway expansion, and foundation) will be no more than four feet deep.
- Transporting 210 cubic yards soil (about 14 truckloads) to a permitted disposal facility.
- Covering excavated area with clean soil, asphalt, and/or concrete foundation to restore protective cover.

When will you see work?

- Excavation is expected to occur in three phases from: **May 7, 2018 through November 30, 2018.**
- Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (excluding observed holidays).
- Work may happen on weekends or after hours if necessary.

What safety measures will be in place?

- Workers will control dust by using water, tarps, and foam spray as needed.

- Workers will install and routinely monitor perimeter air monitoring stations to ensure that dust control measures are effective.
- Truckloads will be covered and tires cleaned prior to leaving the site.
- Plastic sheeting will cover stockpiled soil.

Where will you see work?

- At the PG&E Marina Substation located on Bay Street between Buchanan Street and Laguna Street (see map on the reverse side of this notice).

How will the work impact you?

- All streets will be open as usual, with flaggers managing truck and vehicle traffic.
- Trucks will use approved San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency route.
- Noise impacts from jackhammers for removal of concrete foundation.

Who will do the work?

- PG&E will be conducting the soil excavation work with oversight from the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC).
