Background Information:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), incorporated in California in 1905, is one of the largest combination natural gas and electric utilities in the United States. Based in San Francisco, the company is a wholly owned subsidiary of PG&E Corporation.

There are approximately 20,000 employees who carry out PG&E’s primary business—the transmission and delivery of energy. The Company provides natural gas and electric service to approximately 14 million people throughout a 70,000-square-mile service area in northern and central California. Our customers include over 20,000 schools, 3,000 hospitals, 20,000 high-tech companies and 700 military facilities. As the primary gas and electric service provider for Central and Northern California, PG&E has impressive size and territory that stretches from Eureka to Bakersfield and from the Pacific Ocean to the Sierra Nevada. PG&E provides electricity to over 4.9 million customers and gas to over 3.9 million customers.

PG&E is determined to expand opportunities which enhance our commitment to diversity, safety, environmental stewardship, and corporate integrity. We anticipate the evaluation process will provide opportunities for successful firms to expand their business with PG&E. This opportunity also allows PG&E to realize reductions in costs, both internal and external and to enhance PG&E’s operations.

Program Description:

PG&E proposed a behind-the-meter (BTM) thermal energy storage program named “WatterSaver” program with a goal of providing at least two and up to five Megawatts (MW) of peak load reduction by 2025. To achieve this reduction, PG&E proposed to use both new HPWHs and to install smart control devices to existing ERWHs and HPWHs to shift load away from peak usage hours.

The purpose of this Request for Information (RFI) is to collect program implementation, product information and technology application ideas that adhere to program requirements to inform the construction of a Request for Proposal (RFP) for a program implementer for PG&E’s WatterSaver Program in late 2019.
