Contract Opportunity Title: Fuel Cells Decommissioning/Demolition

Request For: Proposal

Estimated Contract Value (Range): \$350,000 - \$650,000

Opportunity Description:

Background:

PG&E, incorporated in California in 1905, is one of the largest combination natural gas and electric utilities in the United States. Based in San Francisco, the company is a wholly owned subsidiary of PG&E Corporation.

PG&E operates three (3) Fuel Cells: one (1) at Cal State East Bay in Hayward and two (2) at San Francisco State University in San Francisco. These Fuel Cells are at the end of their useful lives and must be decommissioned and demolished.

Contract Opportunity Description:

Provide labor and materials required to dismantle all remaining fuel cell components, safely and appropriately dispose of all waste materials, and return the site back to its former state. (All catalyst and desulfurization elements will be removed by others prior to this work commencing.)

Prequalifying Requirements

- Safety Record: If awarded the bid, Contractor and its Subcontractors will be required to be registered in ISNetwork and maintain a qualifying grade, including written safety programs. PG&E requests that your firm provide 2018, 2019 and 2020 EMR, TRIR and DART rates.
- PG&E requests that you provide information regarding your firm's capabilities that will validate that your firm is able to perform the specified work. Provide at least 2 examples of previous jobs your company has performed similar to the RFP work scope described above, including contact reference information for each job.

Supply Chain Responsibility Requirements:

The selected supplier must align with PG&E's Supply Chain Responsibility policies and procedures. The supplier will provide a detailed description of their internal, specific supply chain responsibility program and practices.

Conduct Requirements:

Suppliers, as well as their employees, subcontractors and sub-suppliers, must adhere to the principles and standards outlined in our Supplier Code of Conduct as they provide goods and services to PG&E. Review Code and understand its obligations here:
