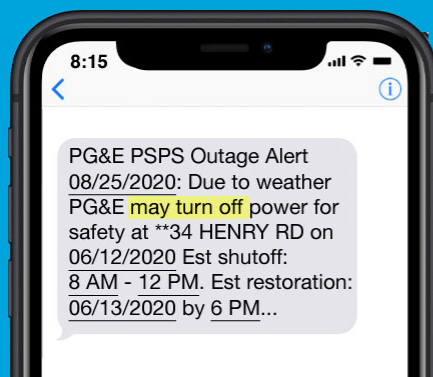




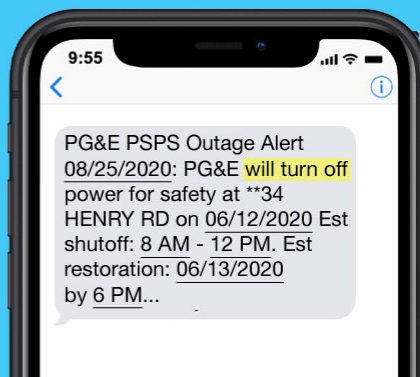

## SAFETY UPDATE

**The difference between Watch and Warning notifications**

We understand how disruptive it is to be without power. We have improved Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) notifications to help you plan for outages. We will send **Watch** notifications two days before and one day before a potential event in your area. When forecasted conditions show a safety shutoff is needed and will happen in the next several hours, a **Watch** will be upgraded to a **Warning**. We use the contact information provided in your account to send notifications via **phone, email and text**.

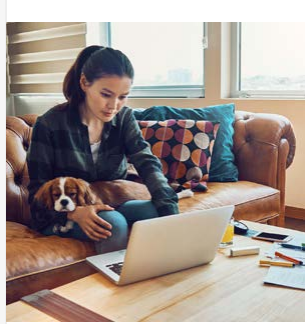

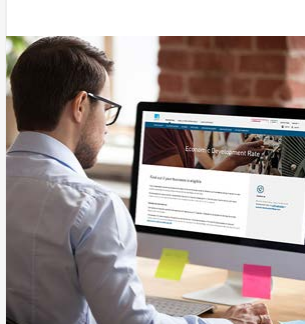
