**DIABLO CANYON DECOMMISSIONING ENGAGEMENT PANEL PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE AND MEETINGS
SCHEDULE UPDATE**

WHAT: The Diablo Canyon Decommissioning Engagement Panel will hold a public meeting at the San Luis Obispo County Government Center on November 14, 2018. The panel will discuss its progress toward making overall 2018 recommendations to PG&E that address the decommissioning process, funding, potential future land use and facilities repurposing. This reflects a change to the meeting schedule discussed at previous public meetings and published on the panel's website. At the October 24, 2018 public meeting, the panel announced the following revised schedule:

- November 14, 2018: 2018 Panel recommendations to PG&E
- December, 2018: Recess
- March 13, 2019: Spent fuel storage

WHO: Panelists represent broad and diverse community viewpoints and live in the communities neighboring Diablo Canyon Power Plant (DCPP). Representatives from PG&E will be present to discuss DCPP decommissioning planning status and to answer questions.

WHEN: Wednesday, November 14, 2018, from 6:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

- Open house poster session for the panel and the public to speak with decommissioning subject matter experts – 6:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Public meeting – 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

WHERE: San Luis Obispo County Government Center, 1055 Monterey St., San Luis Obispo.

WHY: The Diablo Canyon Decommissioning Engagement Panel will help inform PG&E's site-specific decommissioning plan on future land use and repurposing recommendations. The consideration of the plan will be the subject of an ongoing regulatory process that will begin with the filing of the Nuclear Decommissioning Cost Triennial Proceeding in December 2018 at the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). PG&E plans, pending CPUC approval, to continue to engage with the panel and solicit input on its plan during this multi-year review process.
