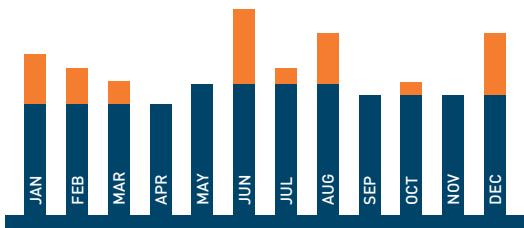

## How Budget Billing works

We average your annual energy costs over 12 months to determine a monthly payment amount, **then** we adjust your monthly amount once **every 4 months** if your actual energy usage has significantly changed. This amount may go up or down.

Once you're enrolled, Budget Billing takes effect on your next billing cycle. This free program is optional, and you can request to begin or end participation at any time.
