<p>Company</p>	<p>Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E)</p>
<p>Whom should I contact for more information?</p>	<p>For more information about PG&E's Green Saver Program, visit pge.com/greensaver or call 877-743-4112.</p>
<p>How will I be billed for PG&E's Green Saver Program?</p>	<p>There is no charge to participate in PG&E's Green Saver Program. Participants in the program will receive a 20% bill credit on their PG&E electric charges.</p>
<p>How will my PG&E's Green Saver bill be calculated?</p>	<p>Your PG&E Green Saver bill will be calculated by applying a 20% discount to the electric bill segment charges on your otherwise applicable rate schedule. This discount will be applied after any applicable discount for the California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) or Family Electric Rate Assistance (FERA) programs, and before any applicable taxes.</p>
<p>Will my rate change over time?</p>	<p>PG&E's Green Saver discount is based on current California Public Utility Commission approved tariffs. Program rules and applicable discounts are subject to change and must be approved by the California Public Utilities Commission.</p>
<p>What other fees might I be charged?</p>	<p>No other fees apply.</p>
<p>What length of agreement /contract is required?</p>	<p>PG&E offers Green Saver on a month to month basis. There is no further length of agreement or contract required.</p>
<p>Can I cancel my participation?</p>	<p>You may cancel your participation in PG&E's Green Saver Program at any time and without a fee. The cancellation will become effective as of your last closed bill period. You will then be ineligible to participate in PG&E's Green Saver Program for a period of 12 months from the date of the change (certain customers may be exempted).</p>
<p>Can I change my participation level?</p>	<p>There is only 1 participation level: 100%.</p>
<p>Can I move and continue to participate in PG&E's Green Saver Program?</p>	<p>It depends. PG&E's Green Saver Program requires that participants live in a Disadvantaged Community, as defined by CalEnviroScreen as the top 25% most impacted census tracts statewide, as well as those census tracts in the highest 5% of CalEnviroScreen's Pollution Burden that do not have an overall CalEnviroScreen score because of unreliable socioeconomic or health data. Additionally, communities located in a San Joaquin Valley pilot community are also eligible to participate. A participant who moves and whose new premise is also located in a Disadvantaged Community, and continues to meet all the other program eligibility rules, may remain on the program. A participant who moves out of a Disadvantaged Community may no longer participate in PG&E's Green Saver Program.</p>
<p>Can I participate in both PG&E's Green Saver and Solar Choice or Regional Renewable Choice programs at the same time?</p>	<p>No. You may only be enrolled in one of these programs at any given time.</p>
