Summer time-of-use rates take effect in May. This means there will be three rate periods starting this summer: **off-peak**, **partial-peak** and **peak**. During peak periods, which are weekdays from noon to 6 p.m., May through October, your business's electric rates will be higher. Time-of-use rates at all other times will be lower than the peak rate.

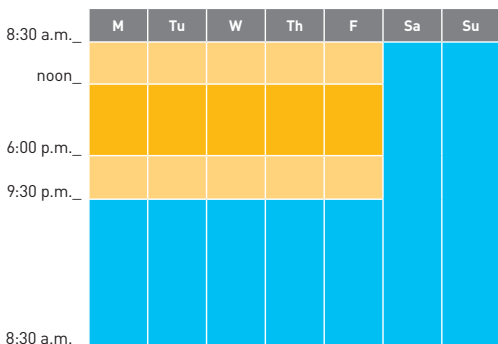

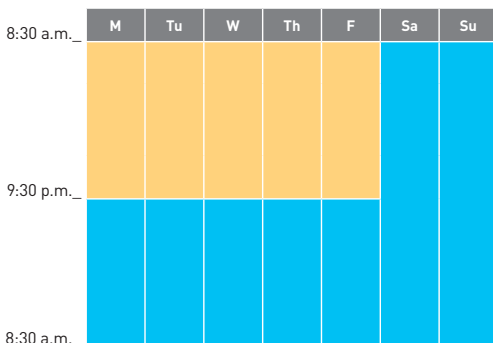
